Just over a year ago two of the biggest names on the house music scene went into the studio together for the first time. On paper, the collaboration didn't really look like it would work. Although both native New Yorkers, their career paths have taken different tangents; **Joeski** came to prominence on the wave of the deep, techy west coast sound through his work on **Siesta & Tango**. **Matthias Heilbronn** is known globally for his soulful, heavily instrumented vocal productions through labels such as **Wave** and **Chez**.

Fast-forward 14 months, and the body of work amassed by the pair shows that you can't predict these things; sometimes all the planets align and there's magic in the air, so much so that what started out as a nice idea has now developed into one of the most eagerly-awaited house albums of recent time.

In the last year **Joeski & Matthias** have released a steady stream of critically-acclaimed tracks, among them the Blues-soaked "**Stuck In A Dream**", the Afro-Latin driven "**Sabrosito**", and the smooth Jazz of "**I Got News**" featuring vocals from Jessica Colasante, all showcasing the diverse, global flavours that have influenced Joeski & Matthias throughout their careers (for a full list and clips of releases so far [click here](#)).

The album is a perfect snapshot of their all-encompassing dj sets. They play in the true spirit of house, taking dancefloors on a journey through a wide spectrum of sounds, all propped up by their trademark heavy tribal beats. Both are equally known as being two of the most accomplished house DJs on the circuit, and after playing together to great acclaim in the states, the duo are now planning a European tour later this year.

Matthias explains: "We've known each other for a long time, but only started working together when I started to play at Joeski's bar, East Side Company, in China Town, just over a year ago. We both go way back, we've both played everything from 100 to 10 000 people, big sound systems, intimate clubs. We can play 10-hour sets by ourselves, or we can do one on one, 1 record each, and it works. I think we are fun to watch together, there is a lot of energy going on, and our sets go from deep tech to classic Chicago to techno, Detroit to organic and soulful."

As well a selection of unreleased mixes of this year's work, the album will feature

a beautiful new vocal project with **Jessica Colasante**, as well as a project featuring **Xaviera Gold** of “**You Used To hold Me**” fame. **Alex Sosa** has been called up for remix duty on “**Stuck In A Dream**”, and the pair are also putting the finishing touches to a seriously hot Detroit-tinged techno joint that has Matthias promising “People will flip when they hear it”.
